

Release Notes: AVG Business Antivirus 21.6 (mid August, 2021)

Windows Antivirus: 21.6

Release Summary

This release contains new improvements and bug fixes to our AVG Business Antivirus client.

Important!

Important: Customers using AVG Remote Administration console will not be able to upgrade their managed devices to the latest antivirus program version. Those devices will stay on 21.4 and we will no longer provide feature updates to it. Virus database will still be updated to keep your users safe. As a reminder to AVG Remote Administration users, this console will reach its End of Life (EOL) by the end of 2021. Migration to AVG Business Cloud console during 2021 is heavily recommend to all AVG Remote Administrations users. Please find detailed migration steps described in [this link](#).

Improvements

- **Useful Smart Scan notifications** — We've fine-tuned the behaviour of Smart Scan with improved initialization steps and ensured that you receive proper notifications about scheduled scans.
- **Fewer interruptions in fullscreen** - When you're running another app fullscreen, our antivirus will no longer open on top and interrupt you. We apologize if this happened to you! (And don't worry, threat warnings will still appear, so you'll always know about malware even while watching your favourite film).
- **Updated privacy policies** - We've updated our General Privacy Policy and other connected privacy policies. You can [find them here](#)

Bug fixes for:

- The latest renderer version **stopped supporting CPUs with SSE2**, so we needed to add an install block and freeze users using these older pieces of hardware on 21.4 version (relevant for lower tens of thousands of users)
- Fixed cases of **infinite loader** when turning off some of the core shields via Settings
- Fixed **support tool** (collection logs and info for customer support and debugging) that was not properly grabbing AV status and subscription status in RE, plus it now reports WSC status
- Fixed **removal of scheduled tasks**
- Fixed a case when some **antivirus windows opened in the background** (behind other full-screen app) even if this was not desired while interacting with it
- Added support for the **Tools** category of the **Potential Unwanted Programs**
- Fixed a **tray icon error** that showed an issue notification despite everything being OK
- Fixed a **Firewall issue** where driver aswNetHub.sys caused a BSOD

- Fixed a **leak of GDI objects**
- Fixed the **AVG Clear utility**, which didn't properly remove the antivirus from Windows Security Centre
